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

The 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebrations were held at Rani Seethai Hall, Chennai. The programme commenced with our children singing Vasantham's prayer song, followed by the traditional lighting of the kuthuvilakku by guests Shri. 'Crazy' Mohan & Shri.
